CHAPTER III

Ranking of Candidates

After examining the applications submitted, the Evaluation Committee shall rank the candidates according to priority order, provided that they possess the required qualifications.

The ranking of candidates, on the basis of which the final selection for engagement under a **Project Service Contract (PSC)** will be made, shall proceed as follows:

1. Main Qualifications

Priority shall be given to candidates who possess the principal qualifications required for the position.

2. Ranking of Candidates with Equal Qualifications

Where candidates possess the same principal qualifications, ranking shall be determined in descending order on the basis of:

- Greater relevant professional experience;
- Duration of unemployment;
- Large-family status;
- Three-child family status;
- Number of minor children;
- Single-parent family status;
- Degree grade;
- Professional experience;
- Disability of the candidate;
- Disability of a family member.

3. Tie-Breaking Procedure

In the event of a tie between candidates, priority shall be given to the candidate with the greater length of relevant professional experience.

If equality still remains, the candidate with the greater number of points under the criterion relating to children of a large family shall prevail, and so on according to the order of the criteria.

If all criteria are exhausted and equality still remains, the order of ranking shall be determined by a public draw.

CHAPTER IV

Publication of Ranking Tables and Submission of Objections

Following the preparation of the ranking table, Polyrhythmia shall communicate and publish the ranking lists of candidates no later than twenty (20) days after the expiry of the application submission deadline:

CHAPTER V

Conclusion of the Contract

The Company shall engage the selected personnel under a **Project Service Contract (PSC)** following completion of the ranking procedure and the signing of the contract, with commencement on the date of the events.

Candidates who are engaged and subsequently withdraw before the expiration of their contract shall be replaced by other available candidates from the corresponding ranking list, according to their order of ranking.

In all cases, candidates engaged either:

- following a revision of the ranking tables after objections; or
- as replacements for withdrawing candidates,

shall be employed only for the remaining period of the approved contract duration.

Note

If the number of interested candidates corresponds to the number of positions announced and the Committee determines during the initial review that all required qualifications are satisfied, the time required for the final selection and conclusion of the Project Service Contract (PSC) may be shortened.
